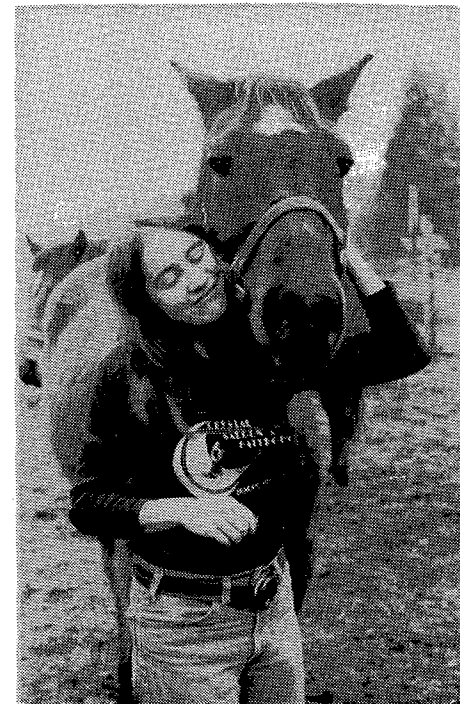
Clarity

My Heart Sings

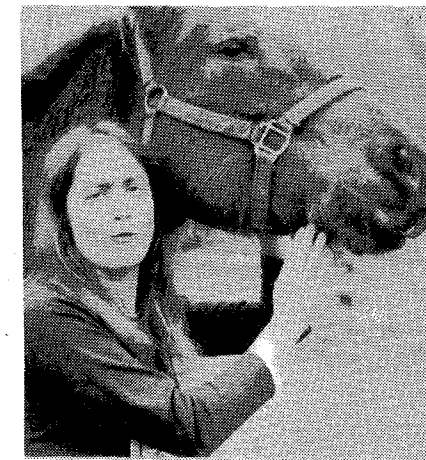
My heart sings,

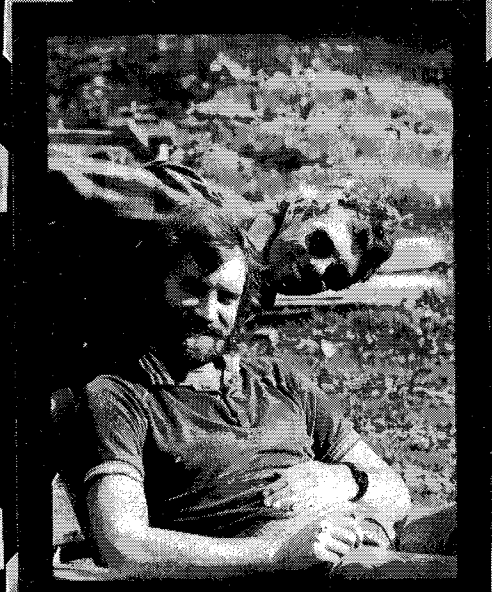
